

Five Balloons

Age: 3-6 (Parents participation is highly recommended) **Players:** 2-4
contains: 20 Balloon Cards - 4 of each color. 24 Event Cards
(question mark on the back).

Object of the game:

To have the most balloons at the end of the game.

Getting ready:

1. Separate the Balloon Cards from the Event Cards.
2. Deal each player 5 Balloons (if there are spare balloons, put them back in the box).
3. Each player lays his 5 balloons in front of him - face up.
4. Shuffle the Event Cards and place them in the center face down as a draw pile.

How to play:

Each player in his turn (clockwise) turns over an Event Card and places it beside the draw pile face up. If this event involves a balloon or balloons in a color which he has, he loses these balloons and must turn over those cards. If he doesn't have any balloons of that color he is saved and does not lose any balloon.

Mother card:

A player who draws a Mother Card receives a new balloon. If he already lost at least one balloon, he turns one back. If he still has 5 balloons, he receives another one.

End of the game:

A player who loses all his balloons is out of the game.
The winner is the one who is left with the most balloons after all the Event Cards have been used.
